The company announces that Fukuda Life Tech Yokohama Co., Ltd., a subsidiary of the company, has mistakenly lost documents listing patients' information.

In spite of ongoing efforts to strictly and thoroughly manage documents such as these that contain personal information, we must deeply apologize for the fact that such a situation as this has arisen and for the considerable inconvenience and worry we have caused patients and the medical institutions where the patients are receiving medical examinations.

We fully accept the seriousness of this situation and deeply recognize the importance of managing information including personal information, and shall make additional efforts to manage information all the more thoroughly and prevent information from being lost again.

Details

1. Content of Missing Personal Information

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* In addition, reports (in company format, listing model and serial No. of equipment used) made when equipment was installed and/or maintenance and inspection were performed at the homes of 30 of the above 170 patients also has been lost.

2. Background to This Loss

At 8 p.m. on September 11, 2009, we received a report from an employee of the Hamamatsu Sales Office of Fukuda Life Tech Yokohama Co., Ltd., a subsidiary of the company, that documents listing patients' information were mistakenly lost in the course of his duties.

3. Future Measures

We have reported this to the police authorities, however, at present we have not received any confirmation of the whereabouts of this information.

Our company will explain the background to this incident and will apologize individually to patients and the medical institutions where the patients are receiving medical examinations.

At present, no harm such as illegal use of personal information has been confirmed.
